You Qualify to Receive Money From the adidas Missouri Tax Settlement

Records show that you qualify for a payment from a class action Settlement because a tax rate higher than the Vendor's Use Tax Rate was applied to at least some of your purchases from adidas. The lawsuit claims that adidas charged higher state tax to Missouri consumers who made remote (internet) purchases from adidas's website. adidas denies it did anything wrong, but is resolving the claims against it to avoid further litigation.

What Does the Settlement Provide? A Settlement Fund will pay (1) money to eligible Class Members; (2) the costs of notice and administration; (3) a service award to the class representative; and (4) attorneys' fees, costs, and expenses. Records indicate that the total amount of Potential Tax Overcharges you paid is \$<<<table>

How Can I Get a Payment? As long as your PayPal Account is **linked to this email address**, you do not need to do anything. You will receive an automatic payment via PayPal to the email account that was used to make the qualifying purchase. If you do not have a PayPal account linked to the email address used to receive THIS email, then you can link it to PayPal now by going to **www.paypal.com**.

Please use the Claimant ID Number <<<Claimant ID>> when making your selection. This number is unique to you, so please do not share it.

What Are My Rights? Even if you do nothing, you will be bound by the Court's decisions. If you want to keep your right to sue adidas yourself, you must exclude yourself from the Settlement by mailing an exclusion to the Settlement Administrator so that it is **postmarked by July 24, 2023** and **received by August 3, 2023**. If you stay in the Settlement then you may object to it by mailing an objection to the Settlement Administrator so that it is **postmarked by August 3, 2023**. The Court will hold a hearing on August 31, 2023, to consider whether to approve (1) the Settlement, (2) a request for attorneys' fees and costs (up to 36% of the Settlement Fund) by class counsel, and (3) a \$5,000 service award to the class representative. You or your own lawyer may appear and speak at the hearing at your own expense. The date and time of the hearing may change, so it is a good idea to check the Settlement website for updates.
